**The Limerick Navigation** - Wednesday 15th January 2020 @ 7:30pm in the Lakeside Hotel, Ballina/Killaloe. Brian J. Goggin is going to tell us all about the Limerick Navigation which, despite it's name, was mainly in Co Clare. Built from 1750 onwards to link Lough Derg, and the rest of the Shannon, to Limerick, it remained in use until the Shannon Scheme came into effect in the 1920s. Brian will give us a photographic tour of what remains of the navigation, showing the wealth of historic features that are still to be seen and he will also highlight some of the problems with the design. Entry to this lecture is FREE as usual, and everyone of all ages and levels of interest is welcome.
