## St. Valentine

Today, 14<sup>th</sup> February, is St. Valentine's Day, widely celebrated as an occasion for the expression, especially by young people, of romantic love and devotion. St. Valentine lived in the 3<sup>rd</sup> century AD. Because of his commitment to Christianity, he was tortured and martyred by the Roman emperor, Claudius, in the year 270AD.

In 1836, Fr. John Spratt, an Irish priest and famous preacher, was given a gift by Pope Gregory XVI consisting of the remains of St. Valentine and a small vessel tinged with his blood. These relics were brought to Whitefriar Street Church in Dublin (- just off Grafton St.) where they remain to this day. The Church has become a place of pilgrimage for the more romantic.
