Plaque Unveiling - In a short ceremony in Quin church this Sunday (18th Sept.), 11am, Fr. McCormack will formally unveil and bless the recently-erected plaque which commemorates Fr. Murphy and Fr. Little, both pastors of this parish in the period around the year 1900..

Tax Rebate; Under Irish taxation law, the Revenue Commissioners will regard religious parish units as charitable institutions. This enables the parish to claim rebate of tax in respect of the total annual contribution each parishioner makes to the local parish church, provided that total is at least €250. In such cases, the parishioner is asked to give approval to the proposal (by signing tax form CHY3). This authorisation lasts for five years. If you have signed a CHY3 form in recent years you won't be asked again until the five year period is up. Otherwise, the Parish Secretary will forward the relevant information to you by mail and ask for early return of completed CHY3 form.. The system has become an important source of revenue for the parish.
