Priests' Summer Collection: The quarterly collection for the priests of the parish is being taken up today – though it was scheduled for last weekend 11/12th June. We regret that, due to an oversight, no advance notice was given to parishioners for this collection..

Parish Pastoral Council: Our parish may be regarded as a vibrant Christian community where people strive to live the Gospel in their daily lives and gather weekly in our churches (3) to celebrate the Eucharist. We obtain leadership from our priests, working with a number of dedicated lay people in groups such as the Parish Pastoral Council, the Parish Council, the Liturgy group, and others. The Pastoral Council's primary role is to plan for the future of the Church in our parish - at a time of great change and challenge. It renews itself regularly by bringing in committed new members each year. Last Monday (13th June), Nita Enright, President for the past three years, stepped down and was replaced, as President, by John Wall. Four other members, who had also served three years, were replaced by some new faces. We wish John and the new Council every success in the challenges ahead. We also wish to pay a special tribute to Nita for the excellence of her leadership and her dedication at all times during her term of office.

Spencilhill - The world-famous Spencilhill Fair is almost upon us - it happens **next Thursday, 23rd June** – the traditional date. It should be noted, however that, in recent times, Spencilhill has become more than just a one-day Fair. A **Community Festival** has grown up around the event. This will start on **Tuesday evening next**, 21st June, with a History Walk in the Spencilhill area, led by local historian, Joe Queally, starting from Duggans at 7pm. All welcome. Then on **Wednesday, 22nd June**, starting at 5pm, at Duggans field, an evening of **Family Fun** will include events such as Tractor Balancing, bicycle races for U10s & U12s (- bring your own bike), donkey derby, penalty kicks, etc. A unique feature of the event will be a **display** by Sergiy Khimich of the Zaporozhian Cossack Show of Russia – as seen at the recent Dubai and Melbourne International Horse Shows.
