**Ireland's Camino**? Next Sunday, 30<sup>th</sup> July, is "*Reek Sunday*" when the annual Pilgrimage to Croagh Patrick (Co. Mayo), takes place. Many thousands will make the difficult climb to the summit. There, Mass will be celebrated every hour, on the hour, from 8am to 2pm. The tradition of pilgrimage on Croagh |Patrick goes back 5,000 years to the Stone Age. In 441 AD, St Patrick fasted on the summit for 40 days and the custom has been handed down from generation to generation. Some pilgrims avoid Reek Sunday to climb at times that would be safer. Many of next week's pilgrims will also have "done" the Camino, world-famous pilgrimage routes, commemorating St. James the Apostle, to Santiago de Compostela, in the N-W corner of Spain. .,
