**Man of Peace:** Oliver Plunkett was born in 1628 into a noble and wealthy family in Co Meath. He studied for the priesthood in the Irish college in Rome and was ordained in 1654. During the penal times he was appointed Archbishop of Armagh and Primate of Ireland. Oliver was a man of peace who courageously preached and worked for reconciliation knowing that a price was on his head. He faithfully did what he was ordained to do. Falsely accused of treason, he suffered a martyr's death on 1st July 1681. Before giving his life, he publicly forgave all who were responsible for his own death. We thank God for the work of peace and reconciliation achieved in our country, something that was so dear to the heart of this courageous saint. On Saturday next 1st July, we celebrate the Feast of St Oliver Plunkett.
