17th December 1936 - 21st April 2025

The news of Pope Francis's death on Easter Monday morning has left the

Catholic Church and our world in deep sadness and grief. Pope Francis will be

remembered for his humility, compassion and unwavering commitment to the

God's mercy, social justice and care for creation reached out to so many
