New Tabernacle: A Restored Tabernacle has been installed in St. Mary’s Church, Quin during the week. The Tabernacle came from Mount Carmel Convent in Dublin. All refurbishment, and manufacturing of design with instalment was carried out by ICS Church Furnishings, the same company that carried out works previously in the Church. Total cost of all works and instalment is €2,840 +VAT. A donor, from outside the Parish and who wishes to remain anonymous has donated €2,900 for this project. We thank Sr. Bridget Finnucane of the Little Company of Mary, Milford for the tabernacle and the donor for their very generous contribution towards the cost. All both ask is that you keep them in your prayers.

Clooney Spencilhill Community Development Group: The Clooney Spencilhill Community Development (Environment) Group have entered a three year partnership with the SEAI. The community of Clooney, Spencilhill and Maghera have signed up as a Sustainable Energy Community (SEC) and have been successful in obtaining funding to carry out an energy master plan. The aim as far as possible is to be energy efficient, achieve financial and energy savings, leverage funding and contribute to energy reduction. The first part of the partnership is to carry out surveys and audits in the area. Mentors from the SEAI and CLDC have been approved. Tipperary Energy Agency (TEA) is the company that has been appointed to carry out this work. The energy master plan should be completed by 21st June 2021. This will provide the foundation and road-map for projects (retrofit, energy projects - community, residential, business etc) and release funding and grants. TEA and the local environment group will guide you in the process and help in identifying energy initiatives.
