So don't be alone with your problem.

**Holy Year**: Back in 1950 which the Pope of the time (Pius XII) declared a *Holy Year*, it inspired Catholics all over the world to make pilgrimages to Rome, the Eternal City, the focus of the Year's devotion and celebration. Many thousands came from Ireland, travelling by various means at a time of great privation globally (- only five years after the end of World War II). Several Irish people travelled by bicycle, taking weeks to get there and back, and some hardy souls even *walked* all the way to Rome as part of their personal pilgrimage.

No such hardship is expected – or advisable – in this Holy Year of 2016. Many will, however, go on pilgrimage for the first time to various places of prayer, including Rome. Cheap air travel, certainly not available in 1950, can now be availed of by everyone, and travel companies look after every detail of accommodation and travel in their package deals. The Diocese of Killaloe will have several such organised pilgrimages - to Rome, Lourdes, Fatima, the Holy Land (Israel), Medjugorje, etc. and many parish groups will be organised to avail of such offers. Further details of these pilgrimages will be supplied in forthcoming issues of the Newsletter.
