He went to Dalgan, Co. Meath in September 1945 and was ordained a priest on 21 December 1951.

He was assigned to the Philippines, to the Zambales District of Luzon Province, Fr. Donal would spend the next sixty years in that area, serving its various parishes. He began as an assistant in Sta Cruz parish before becoming Pastor in Iba, then Palawig, followed by Masinloc. By 1973 he where he became Superior of the Zambales District 1984-1990. There ments to St. Joseph's, Olongapo, Sta Cruz and Barreto, Olongapo.

He worked with the Aeta indigenous peoples who were forced to move to the lowlands where they were scattered and neglected after the eruptionof Mount Pinatubo in 1991. Fr. Donal would spend the next twenty years helping the people at such tasks as acquiring land, houses and food for work to clear the land and literacy classes. Fr. Donal finally retired to Ireland and the Columban Fathers in Dalgan in June 2012. Fr. Donal was a regular visitor to the Parish of Quin, Clooney, Maghera during his years on Mission and when in retirement. At his Funeral Mass, Fr. Pat Raleigh, the main celebrant, thanked the people

of Quin, Clooney Maghera on behalf of the family and the Columban Fathers for all their kindness and support to Fr. Donal over the years. He especially mentioned the support of the Apostolic Works Society here in the Parish, to which Fr. Donal's mother Nell was a founding member. We remember and give thanks to God for Fr. Donal's gentle, kind, loving presence, and his wry sense of humour when he was with us here in the Parish. He was a very dedicated missionary of the Church. He died peacefully in Dublin's Mater Hospital on Friday 26 July
