WMOF Retiring Collection: Next weekend Nov. 10th/11th there will be a retiring collection for the fifth and final collection to defray the costs for hosting the World Meeting Of Families last August. The overall cost to the Church in Ireland for hosting WMOF comes to €19.4m. To date €15.4m has been raised by way of local church collections and by other donations. This leaves us with a deficit of €4m. Please be as generous as you possibly can. We thank you for the outstanding generosity given thus far to previous collections.
