Diocesan Pastoral Plan: Some months ago, the Diocese initiated a review of the Pastoral Plan, the blueprint for future change in each of the parishes making up the Catholic Diocese of Killaloe. Parishioners in Quin-Clooney-Maghera were invited to make submissions to the review team. The work of this evaluation process has now been completed and copies of the full report may be obtained. An overview of its contests – An Executive Summary – is now available. Copies may be picked up at the doorway as you leave after Mass today.

Community Games: The pinnacle of under-age sporting excellence in Ireland – the National Finals of Community Games – will take place at Athlone over the next two weekends, **August 12th to 14th & August 19th to 21st**. The first weekend features Sporting & Cultural events for teams and individuals. The second will focus entirely on *Track & Field* athletics. The amazing aspect of the National Finals this year (and previously) is that there is a hugely disproportionate number of talented young people from our -relatively small - parish (in age groups U8s to U16s) representing their own county, Clare. It is probably quite unique, and this distinction reflects great credit on the young people themselves, their families, the community at large, and the wonderfully dedicated people who organise and train them – for absolutely no gain to themselves.

Having already amassed gold medal awards at *County* (and, in some cases, *Provincial* level) Quin/Clooney will have huge numbers competing for Clare on both weekends. Next weekend alone, we will have representatives in *Group Singing, Individual Cross Country* (1200m), *Mixed Distance Relays: Swimming-Girls, Swimming-Boys; Choir (all Quin/Clooney); Tag Rugby (- team all Q/C); Skittles–U12 (all Q/C), Skittles-U16 (all Q/C); and Cycling on Grass.* We should be so proud of them all. They are true Olympians – and they're the future of our community!
