HISTORY IN THE MAKING One hundred and thirty seven years ago a herdsman from the townland of Dromdoolaghty in Knockanean, Doora was murdered as he was on his way home from Sunday mass at the Franciscan Friary in Ennis. The man John Doolaghty who lived in Dromdoolaghty with his wife and family lost his life through a local land agitation dispute. Another local man Francie Hynes, known to the murdered man was charged with the murder and executed in September 1882. It was the belief that the executed man was executed in the wrong. A great grand daughter of the murdered man Catherine Delahunty living in Newzeland and well on in years has written a book on the story. The book will be launched in the grove bar Roslevan on Tuesday night 9th of July at 9.00pm by Dr Ciaran O'Murchada .
