Around the World - from Quin: As of this moment, on 8th July 2018, Declan McEvoy of Quin is about half-way through the third phase of his round-the-world odyssey, a circumnavigation of the globe - on his motorcycle. He is currently travelling south on the Pacific Highway through California, heading toward Panama and the continent of South America. His ultimate target is to cross all five continents, logging at least 50,000 miles, before finally completing his marathon trek back in Quin (perhaps in 2020). Taking leave-of-absence from work, each phase lasts about 10 weeks. In phase 1 (2016), he visited 24 countries in Europe and Eurasia. Last year (2017), he traversed the vast expanses of Eastern Europe, embracing Russia, Mongolia, Siberia, as far east as is possible to go. This year, he took up the journey in Alaska, across the Bering Strait from Siberia, and proceeded southwards through Canada and into the US. Ennis Parish, led by Fr Tom Hogan, will make a **pilgrimage to Italy on October 15-22**. They will fly from Dublin to Bari in the heel of Italy and spend the first three nights at the shrine of Padre Pio in San Giovanni Rotondo. This is a very special year as it is the 50th anniversary of the death of Padre Pio and the 100th anniversary of the appearance of the stigmata, the wounds of Christ, on his body. The group will then drive to Sorrento, visiting the lovely town of Pietrelcina on the way. Padre Pio was born here and the whole town is filled with places associated with him.
