Frank O'Meara, RIP

Frank O'Meara died peacefully in Limerick University Hospital on 25th September after a short illness. He was 85 years of age. Born in Dublin, he qualified as an Architect, and came to live in Quin in 1973 and had resided ever since on Newline Road A man of extraordinary zeal for his Catholic faith, he devoted much of his life to prayer, penance and good works. He felt that the full richness of the Catholic faith was to be found in the more traditional liturgies of the Tridentine form and the Latin rite. As an architect, he obtained many commissions locally, but it was as an artist he became known far and wide. He specialised in water-colours and his paintings are to be found in many parts of Ireland, Britain and the US. May he rest in peace.
