Apostolic Works: The annual display of work from all the branches of the Diocese takes place on Saturday next, 24th June from 2pm to 4pm in the Maria Assumpta Hall Station Road Ennis. The Quin branch is one of the most active in the Diocese supporting the work of Missionaries by their work and fundraising.
